Submission Checklist

Please make sure you have included the following before you send off your sample (failure to do so will result in your sample not being identified OR returned):

- 3 ALMOST RIPE and NUMBERED fruit specimens and a shoot with representative foliage. (The fruit should be in good condition, as damaged, misshapen or poor specimens are very difficult to name. If possible the fruit should be mature and show the characteristic size shape and colour), number the fruit on the skin with a marker (anything stuck to the skin may become removed in transit) **If the fruit is over ripe or likely to go over in transit then please select a different sample as mouldy and rotten fruit cannot be identified.**
- A cheque for £20 (per variety to be identified)(Cheque made payable to: Brogdale Collections) you can also by card over the phone PRIOR to us receiving your sample - this can be done by calling brogdale collections on 01795 536 250 9am till 4pm, Mon-Fri.
- Your completed submission form (you will receive your identification results by email (preferred) or post if no email address is provided).
